**From the East:** Interstate Route 80 West through New Jersey to Exit 4 (Columbia/Blairstown). Follow signs to Portland, PA / Delaware River Toll Bridge; continue straight on PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from ❖ below.

**From Central New Jersey –** Take I-287 to I-78 West. Take NJ Route 31 North, then Route 46 West. Follow signs to Portland, PA toll bridge and take PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from ❖ below.

**From the West –** Take Interstate 80 East through PA to Exit 310. Follow PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from ❖ below.

**From Allentown, PA –** Take Route 22 East to PA. 33 North. Exit at PA 191 at Bangor/Stockertown. Take PA 191 North to Bangor. In Bangor, go straight through 2 stop lights. At 3<sup>rd</sup> light (blinking), turn right. Turn left at stop sign. Go 1/4 mile and turn right onto Ridge Road. Go about 3 miles and make sharp left onto Lake Minsi Drive (if you reach a 4-way stop sign intersection when driving on Ridge Road, you have gone too far). On Lake Minsi Drive, follow from ❖❖ below.

- ❖ Turn right on PA 512 (bank and dental office on corner). Go exactly 1.5 miles and turn right onto Lillian Lane. Cross RR tracks and bear to the left up hill. Immediately after a 4-way stop, the road forks; take the right fork; this is Lake Minsi Drive.
- ❖❖ On Lake Minsi Drive, go 0.6 miles. Turn left into gravel lane--mailbox #2167. You are now at **Raspberry Ridge Sheep Farm**. Drive into marked parking areas near house and barn.

**Entry Fees: \$25.00 per Farm Dog Certification (FDC) Test (Outdoors)**  
**\$20.00 per Canine Good Citizen (CGC/A) Test (Indoors)**  
**\$20.00 per any AKC Trick Dog Test (Indoors)**

**You and your smart dog can enter all three tests (Farm Dog, CGC/A, and Trick Dog) in *ONE DAY—Sunday May 3, 2020!***

**1. Eligibility:** Any dog, pure or mixed breed, who has an AKC listing number (we will have forms available day-of to help you get a listing number if you do not already have one), who is at least 9 months old is eligible to enter. Bitches who are in season are ineligible to participate.

**2. Training:** Does your dog need prior, formal training for these tests? *No, but prior training and exposure to test elements helps!* Please go to the AKC website at [www.AKC.org](http://www.AKC.org) to learn more about these tests.

### **3. Equipment**

**For all tests:** Dogs must wear a well-fitted flat collar, be attached to a 4-6 foot leash controlled by a human, and be on leash at all times unless secured safely in a vehicle, kennel, or crate. **Exception:** dogs being tested for Trick Dog are allowed to perform “equipment optional”-- no collar and no leash requirements during Trick Dog tests.

**CGC/A** requires that you supply your own grooming brush/comb.

**Trick Dog** requires that you supply your own props and sound system (if necessary).

### **4. Basic Purposes of Tests Offered During Smart Dog Day:**

- a.) **CGC/A** tests basic obedience and socialization skills of a pet dog.
- b.) **FDC** tests whether your dog can behave as a welcomed farm guest and cope with the unique challenges of a farm environment. It does not test herding ability.
- c.) **Trick Dog** tests give you a chance to show off your smart dog’s entertaining tricks—and there are 5 different title levels to achieve, each more challenging.

Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the Agreement and Rules are unacceptable. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The ATBA treasurer will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with international money orders in US funds. Telephone, telegraph, fax, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to Entry Forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. The ATBA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to accept an entry or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against ATBA or any official thereof. **Entries sent by delivery services must be marked for delivery without a signature.**
