

## DIRECTIONS TO RASPBERRY RIDGE SHEEP FARM

### Raspberry Ridge Sheep Farm, 2167 Lake Minsi Dr, Bangor, PA 18013

**From the East:** Interstate Route 80 West through New Jersey to Exit 4 (Columbia/Blairstown). Follow signs to Portland, PA / Delaware River Toll Bridge; continue straight on PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from \* below.

**From Central New Jersey** – Take I-287 to I-78 West. Take NJ Route 31 North, then Route 46 West. Follow signs to Portland, PA toll bridge and take PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from \* below.

**From the West** – Take Interstate 80 East through PA to Exit 310. Follow PA 611 South through Mt. Bethel. Follow directions from \* below.

**From Allentown, PA** – Take Route 22 East to PA. 33 North. Exit at PA 191 at Bangor/Stockertown. Take PA 191 North to Bangor. In Bangor, go straight through 2 stop lights. At 3rd light (blinking), turn right. Turn left at the stop sign. Go 1/4 mile and turn right onto Ridge Road. Go about 3 miles and make a sharp left onto Lake Minsi Drive (if you reach a 4-way stop sign intersection when driving on Ridge Road, you have gone too far). On Lake Minsi Drive, follow from \*\* below.

\* Turn right on PA 512 (bank and dental office on corner). Go exactly 1.5 miles and turn right onto Lillian Lane. Cross RR tracks and bear to the left, uphill. Immediately after a 4-way stop, the road forks; take the right fork; this is Lake Minsi Drive.

\*\* On Lake Minsi Drive, go 0.6 miles. Turn left into gravel lane--mailbox #2167. You are now at **Raspberry Ridge Sheep Farm**. Drive into parking areas near the house and barn.

For pre-entry discount, entries must be received by May 31, 2024

**Pre-entry by May 31, \$25 per test; Day of event, \$35 per test.** Make check payable to: ATBA. Open to all eligible dogs. This test is open to all breeds. Your dog must be at least 9 months of age and have an AKC number via one of the following:

**AKC Registration Number** – This number is provided to a dog owner via a registration certificate received from the previous owner, or via a puppy registration paper given to the new owner by the breeder.

**Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL)** – If a dog is purebred but an AKC Registration Number is not possible, owners can apply for a PAL number.

**AKC Canine Partners Number** – This number is given to either mixed breed dogs or a purebred.

**Foundation Stock Service®(FSS) Number** – This number is used for breeds whose status is currently in the foundational stage of being recorded into our registry and requires a copy of the dog's pedigree.

**If you need help obtaining an AKC registration/PAL number/Canine Partners/FSS number, ATBA will have forms available on-site that you can fill out and send to AKC on the day-of your entry. For an additional \$3.00, ATBA will supply you with an envelope and stamp to send your application in to the AKC on the day of your test(s).**

Entries not on our Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the Agreement and Rules are unacceptable. Entries will not be accepted without fees. No refund for duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the Club after closing date. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The ATBA treasurer will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with international money orders in US funds. Telephone, telegraph, fax, e-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Changes, additions, or corrections to Entry Forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. The ATBA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to accept an entry or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against ATBA or any official thereof.

**Entries sent by delivery services must be marked for delivery without a signature.**

Pre-Entries close 8:00 PM Wednesday, May 31, 2024.

**Day-of Entries accepted starting at 7:00 am according to availability of judges.**
